



## Upgrade Note for iDevAffiliate 9.0

As of iDevAffiliate 9.0, we have a new feature that allows you to define the incoming traffic page for tier links, when using the **Forced Linking** method.

You will have an extra step to complete if you are using the following settings in your current installation.

- A) You're using the tier system.
- B) You're using **Forced Linking** as the **Tier Linking Style**.

In this case, go to **Commission Settings > Tier Payout Levels** and define your **Alternate Incoming Tier Traffic Page**. Prior to iDevAffiliate 9.0, the people were redirected to the main page of your affiliate program by default.

If in addition to the above two settings you are also using the SEO Links plugin, you will need to re-place your SEO linking code again in your .htaccess file as it has changed to accommodate this new feature. You can find that code at **General Settings > Affiliate Links**. The code provided is slightly different than what you currently have. Just copy/paste the new code over the existing code and save your .htaccess file.
